



Angelo State University Student Emergency Preparedness Checklist

- My information in ASUAlert is accurate and I have denoted how I want to be notified in case of an emergency on campus. (<http://ramport.angelo.edu/cp/home/loginf>)
- I have programmed the ASU Police Department's phone numbers into my cell phone.

- My roommates and/or close friends know how to contact my family or my emergency contact person.
- My family or emergency contact knows how to contact my roommates and/or close friends in case of an emergency.
- I have an entry in my cell phone labeled I.C.E. (In Case of Emergency) so that police, fire, and EMS can contact my emergency contact if I cannot speak.
- I know more than one way to get out of every building where I live, have classes, activities, and meetings.
-If one exit is blocked, I can get out of the building using a different exit; I am familiar with the fire exits in my living space and in the buildings I am in most frequently.
- I know where to shelter in case of severe weather or an active shooter on campus.
-For severe weather shelter areas, I should avoid: windows and areas where there might be flying glass, exterior walls, and rooms with high ceilings. I should try to get to one of the lowest levels in the building except during times of flooding.
- When I go out at night, I have a plan on how I will get home.
-I have friends who I can call to pick me up if I get stuck at a party or location where I feel uncomfortable. My roommates/friends know where I am going and the people I am with.
- I know how to get to the ASU Health Clinic or a local hospital if I get sick.
- I know the housing staff for my residence hall, including my Resident Assistant, Area Coordinator and other staff in case there is an emergency.
- I have an emergency kit that includes a flashlight, a weather radio, fresh batteries, non-perishable food, a first aid kit, and other items.
