- 5. All points count toward the Greek Week FS Award.
- 6. Results will be announced at the end of the week.

Greek Week NFS Award

- 1. Competing NFS organizations must register to participate in the competition.
- 2. An organization roster must be submitted and verified.
- 3. Team members must be in that organization to participate.
- 4. Teams for each event do not have to be the same people, just be a member of the same organization.
- 5. All points count toward the Greek Week NFS Award.
- 6. Results will be announced at the end of the week.

Most Spirited

- 1. All organizations have the right to vote. One organization cannot vote for itself.
- 2. This award should go to the organization that demonstrates the most spirit throughout the week.
- 3. Results will be announced at the end of the week.

- 2. All pots of chili will be prepared and cooked on location. If not prepared or cooked on location the chili entry will be disqualified.
- 3. Each organization is responsible for cooking chili. Organizations accused of allowing non-members to cook their chili will be disqualified.
- 4. A picture of members cooking the dessert and recipe must be submitted with the dessert.
- 5. A minimum donation of \$25 will be requested to participate. All donations will be given to the Make-A-Wish foundation.


