The Pearl of the Concho Writing Project believes that socially responsible approaches to teaching writing support the education and success of San Angelo's culturally and linguistically diverse student population. This year's Writing Camp will be a week-long investigation of the fun and engagement of non-fiction writing. All teachers are encouraged to apply, but special consideration will be given to teachers in grades 3-5. Teachers who have participated in previous PCWP writing camps are welcome for this non-fiction themed camp.

Who Should Apply?

The TWC is designed for K-12 educators who have experience with teaching writing and a desire to learn more about nonfiction writing. Applications should have an interest in becoming a part of a professional community of practitioners. All grade levels and disciplines can apply but teachers of grade levels 3-5 will be given special consideration. Notifications of acceptance will be made by May 10, 2014.

Upon completion of the TWC, participants receive a 250.00 stipend as well as classroom materials.
