Pre-Business Requirements

All students declaring majors and/or applying for degree programs in the College of Business, starting Fall of 2008, will be placed in a pre-business classification (BBA_PREB) until they complete the lower-division courses listed below. Students in the pre-business classification may not enroll in upper-division business courses. *This includes students who are transferring or changing majors.*

Students who have completed the lower-division courses in Group 1 and Group 2 may apply to be reclassified for BBA degree majors if the following requirements are met:

- a) have an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher*
- b) have an official degree plan (ODP) on file for the intended major,
- c) be registered with Career Development with resume on file, and
- d) file an application for advanced standing with the Center for Student Success in Rassman 102.

Group 1:

In addition to the requirements specified above, the student will complete the following lower-level courses (27 credit hours) with no grade lower than a **C**, and a cumulative GPA in this group of 2.0 or higher.* Group 1 courses should be successfully completed prior to filing the application.

ENG 1301 (English Composition)
MATH 1324 (Finite Math)
MATH 1325 (Business Calculus & Finite Math II)
BCIS 1305 (MIS majors take CS 1341) (Business Computer Information Systems)
ACC 2301 and 2302 (Principles I & II)
ECO 2301 and 2302 (Macro and Micro)
MSC 2331 (Management Science = Business Statistics)

Group 2:

These courses are required by the University as part of the student's general education core. Grades of D do not have to be repeated; however, the overall GPA in this group must be 2.0 or higher.* (32 credit hours).

ENG 1302 and Sophomore Literature (select from ENG 2323, 2324, 2325, 2328),
Philosophy (2301 or 2311) or Culture (2323) ***
HIST 1301 and 1302
POLS 2301 and 2302
COMM 2301
Science with lab 8-hours (see back side)
Art, Music, Theatre 3-hours select from: (ART 1301, 1305, 2301)
(MUS 1310, 1341, 1342, 1351, 1375, 1376, (TH 1311) ***

***Please note these are the ONLY courses which meet CORE CURRICULUM requirements.

TRANSFER CREDITS:

Beginning Fall 2011 – courses transferred are applied to the degree if the course is equivalent and the grade is a C or better.

Grades of D are not transferable.

***Only courses taken at ASU will be used to calculate your GPA and to determine academic standing.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

IBUS, MGT, MKT and MIS majors are required to take BA 1301.

MGT and MKT majors are required to take either PSY 2301 or SOC 2301.

GUIDELINES FOR SCIENCES COURSES

You are required to take eight semester credit hours in science.

That means you must take at least two laboratory courses.

The following are recommended:

- BIO 1410 (Human Biology) and BIO 1411. (Man and the Environment)
- CHEM 1301 and 1101. CHEM 1302 and 1102. (Elements of Chemistry)
- GEOL 1401 (Physical Geology) and 1402. (Historical Geology)
- PHYS 1301 and 1101. PHYS 1302 and 1102. (Fundamentals of Astronomy)
- PS 1301 and 1101. PS 1302 and 1102. (Physical Science)
- PS 1403. (Introduction to Space Science)
