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The above plan meets all core curriculum and Bachelor of Arts degree requirements. The BA degree with a major in English requires a minimum of 120 semester credit hours, a minimum of 45 advanced semester hours, and a minimum of 33 semester credit hours in residence (24 of which must be at the advanced level).

The English major requires a total of 36 semester hours, of which 24 must be advanced. These advanced hours must include at least three hours from British literary period courses before 180) (3301, 3311, or 3312), at least three hours from American literature courses, and three hours in language studies (4358 or 4361). English majors may specialize in professional writing (see below*). For majors who do not seek specialization, English 4353 is strongly recommended along with courses that have a strong literature base.

* English majors may specialize in professional writing by selecting the following courses from the major program: English 3351 or 3352, 3353, 4358, 4361, 4360, 4373, and at least 12 hours of advanced literature courses, preferably with a strong writing component. Students should work closely with advisors in respective major departments to plan a degree program that best fits individual needs and goals.

**Students may take either 3351 or 3352 for advanced credit - not both.
